WASHINGTON, DC – January 5, 2018 – On Sunday, Federal Aviation Administration Deputy Administrator Dan Elwell will become the FAA's Acting Administrator when Administrator Michael Huerta's term expires. The Small UAV Coalition thanks Administrator Huerta for his service during a transformative time in American aviation and congratulates Acting Administrator Elwell on his new role.

Former FAA Chief Counsel Gregory Walden, Aviation Counsel to the Small UAV Coalition, said "Acting Administrator Elwell assumes this role at an exciting, but critical, juncture for the United States. His storied career in aviation, penchant for decisive action, and creativity are necessary during this formative time for the commercial UAS industry."
