Coalition Members to Participate in Unmanned Aircraft Systems Registration Task Force

Nine Members to Represent Small UAV Industry Views

WASHINGTON, DC – OCTOBER 29, 2015 – Nine Small UAV Coalition members will serve on the Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) Registration Task Force, Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Administrator Michael Huerta announced today, representing 3D Robotics, Airmap, Amazon Prime Air (and Amazon Retail), DJI, GoPro, Parrot, and PrecisionHawk. Dave Vos of Google[X], another Coalition member, will co-chair the Task Force with FAA UAS Integration Office Director Earl Lawrence.

Secretary of Transportation Anthony Foxx and Administrator Huerta announced last week that a Task Force would be established to make recommendations on a UAS registration program, including requirements and process. The Task Force will meet the first week of November and has been asked to complete its recommendations by November 20.
