Small UAV Coalition Comments on Security Proposals Looks Forward to Promoting Innovation During Development of a Reasonable UAS Security Policy

WASHINGTON, DC – May 25, 2017 – The Small UAV Coalition has long supported initiatives to expedite the safe integration of unmanned aerial systems (UAS) into the national airspace. Such advances include operations that are autonomous, over people, and beyond visual line of sight, as well as an unmanned traffic management system (UTM) and a streamlined waiver process.

Yesterday, it was widely reported that the Administration and Congress are considering draft UAS security policy proposals. The Coalition is confident that the United States can be the world leader in ubiquitous UAS services across every sector of the economy and looks forward to working with the Administration on its proposal to develop a reasonable security policy.

To that end, the Coalition stands ready to participate in a collaborative process to maintain American leadership in innovation and technology.
